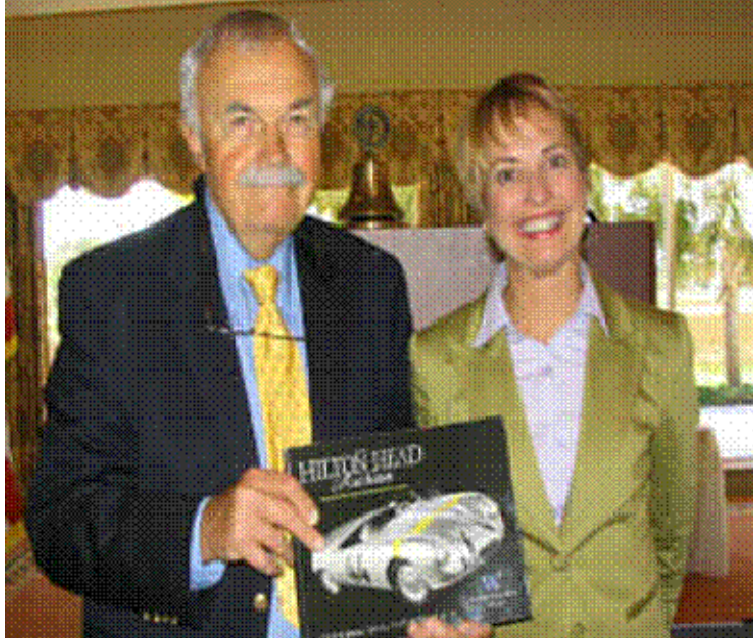
**HILTON HEAD CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE**
